On Friday, February 23, 2018 Lea Regional Medical Center and Hobbs Heart & Vascular partnered to sponsor the Hobbs Hispano Chamber's Pan Dulce y Café. This event

highlighted the cardiac services available in Lea County. February marked the one year anniversary of the Lea Regional Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory, an interventional service that had not previously been available in Lea County. Today, our local citizens who experience life threatening heart attacks no longer have to endure the one to two hours of travel time for life-saving intervention, they can be in Lea Regional's Cath Lab in a matter of minutes.

The Hobbs Heart & Vascular clinic office for patients of Interventional Cardiologists Dr. Charles Moore and Dr. Chip Urrichio. Hobbs Heart & Vascular opened in conjunction with the cath lab. These doctors can manage new onset of cardiac problems and they welcome patients who have a history of cardiac issues.
